Law students at Northeastern University School of Law under the direction of Professor Stevie Leahy investigated the current status of law and public policy in sentencing of juveniles. Supported by a partnership with CLBB and the Transformational Prison Project, the results are available as *Juvenile (in) Justice: The Role of Science and Advocacy in Juvenile Sentencing Post-Jones.* The project confirms great variability of law and practice among the states resulting in "justice by geography" with disconcerting variability in sentencing outcomes.
